CHILDREN ARE PRECIOUS TO JESUS, SO CHILDREN SHOULD BE PRECIOUS TO US.

Mark 10:13-16

And they were bringing children to him that he might touch them, and the disciples rebuked them. ¹⁴ But when Jesus saw it, he was indignant and said to them, "Let the children come to me; do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of God. ¹⁵ Truly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child shall not enter it." ¹⁶ And he took them in his arms and blessed them, laying his hands on them.

Jesus and children

- People were <u>bringing</u> their children to Jesus for Him to bless them – 10:13a
 - The disciples saw children as an interruption 10:13
 - If we love Jesus, we should love what He loves. Children are precious to Jesus, so they should be precious to us – 10:14-15
 - Children reflect a properly basic <u>trust</u>.
 - Jesus considered children worthy of His attention.
 - Jesus elevates children as the ideal <u>citizen</u> of the ultimate kingdom.
- Q: How can I help children come to Jesus?
 - 1) Pour the Word of God into your children and grandchildren.
 - 2) Pray for God to open their heart to the Gospel.

- 3) Let the church help: Grace Kids, Grace Students & AWANA.
- 4) Invite the entire family to Christmas at Grace Sunday, Dec. 23 @ 8:30, 10:00, & 11:30 a.m. Christmas Eve candlelight services @ 5:00 & 7:00 p.m. Dec. 24.
