JOY FINDS ITS SOURCE IN HOPE.

Galatians 5:22a

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy ...

Romans 15:13

May the God of hope fill you with all **joy** and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in **hope**.

John 15:10-11

If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. ¹¹ These things I have spoken to you, that my **joy** may be in you, and that your **joy** may be full.

What is joy?

• Is not an impulsive or fluctuating emotion – Mark 4:16-17 And these are the ones sown on rocky ground: the ones who, when they hear the word, <u>immediately</u> receive it with <u>joy</u>. ¹⁷ And they have no root in themselves, but endure for a while; then, when tribulation or persecution arises on account of the word, <u>immediately</u> they fall away.

Q: What is joy?

A: "[Joy] is a quality, and not simply an emotion, grounded upon God himself and indeed derived from him." 1

Joy finds its root in <u>hope</u> – Romans 15:13 May the God of hope fill you
with all <u>joy</u> and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit
you may abound in <u>hope</u>.

False foundations for joy

• <u>Education</u> — Ecclesiastes 1:17-18 And I applied my heart to know wisdom and to know madness and folly. I perceived that this also is but a striving after wind. ¹⁸ For in much wisdom is much vexation, and he who increases knowledge increases sorrow.

- Relationships Ecclesiastes 2:8 I also gathered for myself silver and gold and the treasure of kings and provinces. I got singers, both men and women, and many concubines, the delight of the sons of man.
 Entertainment Ecclesiastes 2:10-11 And whatever my eyes desired I did
- not keep from them. I kept my heart from no pleasure, for my heart found pleasure in all my toil, and this was my reward for all my toil. ¹¹ Then I considered all that my hands had done and the toil I had expended in doing it, and behold, all was vanity and a striving after wind, and there was nothing to be gained under the sun.
- <u>Career</u> Ecclesiastes 2:20-21 So I turned about and gave my heart up to <u>despair</u> over all the toil of my labors under the sun, ²¹ because sometimes a person who has toiled with wisdom and knowledge and skill must leave everything to be enjoyed by someone who did not toil for it. This

1) <u>Salvation</u> in Jesus Christ.

also is vanity and a great evil.

- 2) Seeing others <u>respond</u> to the Gospel Luke 15:7 Just so, I tell you, there will be more <u>joy</u> in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance.
- 3) **Sanctification**: Becoming more like Jesus Christ.
- 4) Serving others.
- 5) <u>Suffering</u> while remaining faithful to Jesus Christ Hebrews 10:34-35 For you had compassion on those in prison, and you <u>joyfully</u> accepted the plundering of your property, since you knew that you yourselves had a better possession and an abiding one. ³⁵ Therefore do not throw away your confidence, which has a great reward.
