Q: What is repentance?

A: A change of attitude and action from sin toward obedience to God... "to turn around and go in the opposite direction." 1

The repentance and restoration process

 I recognize my capacity and my need – 51:1a <u>Have mercy</u> <u>on me</u>, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy

Q: What opens our eyes to our need?
A: We feel a need to be clean – 51:2 **Wash me** thoroughly from my iniquity, and **cleanse me** from my sin!

A: We cannot escape our guilt – 51:3 For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me.

A: We are broken over breaking God's heart – 51:4-6 Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight, so that you may be justified in your words and blameless in your judgment. ⁵ Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me. ⁶ Behold, you delight in truth in the inward being, and you teach me wisdom in the secret heart.

A: We experience a loss of joy and gladness – 51:8 *Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones that you have broken rejoice.*

- 2) I agree with God about His capacity to meet my need 51:1b <u>blot out</u> my transgressions...⁷ <u>Purge me</u>...<u>wash me</u>...⁹ <u>Hide your face</u> from my sins, and <u>blot out</u> all my iniquities...¹⁰ <u>Create in me</u> a clean heart, O God, and <u>renew</u> a right spirit within me... ¹¹ <u>Cast me not away</u> from your presence, and <u>take not</u> your Holy Spirit from me...

 ¹² <u>Restore to me the joy of your salvation</u>, and <u>uphold me</u> with a willing spirit...¹⁴ <u>Deliver me from bloodguiltiness</u>,
- 3) I place my faith in God to create a story from my scar 51:13 Then <u>I will teach</u> transgressors your ways, and sinners will return to you...¹⁴ O God, O God of my salvation, and <u>my tongue will sing aloud</u> of your righteousness. ¹⁵ O Lord, <u>open my lips</u>, and <u>my mouth will declare</u> your praise.

Q: What does God desire from me? – 51:17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.

Reminders

- 1) You're only one step away from stupid: Whatever sin promises, it's not worth it.
- 2) Stay with a "Who am I?" mentality and look out for a "Look who I am!" attitude.
- 3) Do you have a "Nathan" in your life? Your response to the "Nathans" in your life sets your trajectory.
- 4) You're only one step away from the restoration process: Repentance.
