- Walk with the Tone of your calling 4:2 with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love,
- Walk towards the Target of your calling 4:3-6 eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. ⁴ There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call— ⁵ one Lord, one faith, one baptism, ⁶ one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.
 - O Why eager to maintain unity and peace within the church?
 - Reflects who God is.
 - Keeps us together and on mission.
