Reconciled enemies.

Romans 5:6-11

For while we were still <u>weak</u>, at the right time <u>Christ died</u> for the <u>ungodly</u>. ⁷ For one will scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die— ⁸ but God shows his love for us in that while we were still <u>sinners</u>, <u>Christ died</u> for us. ⁹ Since, therefore, we have <u>now been justified</u> by his blood, much more <u>shall we be saved</u> by him from the wrath of God. ¹⁰ For if <u>while we were enemies we were reconciled</u> to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that <u>we are reconciled</u>, <u>shall we be saved</u> by his life. ¹¹ More than that, <u>we also rejoice</u> in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom <u>we have now received</u> reconciliation.

Us without Jesus Christ

- Weak 5:6a For while we were still weak,
- Ungodly 5:6b-7 at the right time <u>Christ died</u> for the <u>ungodly</u>. ⁷ For one will scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—
- Sinner 5:8b ...while we were still sinners
- Enemy 5:10a For if while we were enemies

Therefore, despair...

Us with Jesus Christ

- Loved 5:8 but <u>God shows his love</u> for us in that while we were still <u>sinners</u>, <u>Christ died</u> for us.
- Justified 5:9 Since, therefore, we have <u>now been justified</u> by his blood, much more <u>shall we be saved</u> by him from the wrath of God.
- Saved 5:9 Since, therefore, we have <u>now been justified</u> by his blood, much more <u>shall we be saved</u> by him from the wrath of God.
- Reconciled 5:10 For if <u>while we were enemies</u> <u>we were</u>
 <u>reconciled</u> to God by the death of his Son, much more, now
 that <u>we are reconciled</u>, <u>shall we be saved</u> by his life.

Therefore, rejoice – 5:11 More than that, <u>we also rejoice</u> in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom <u>we have now</u> received reconciliation.

Action points

- Remember the importance of timing and progression:
 Don't try to learn or do everything at once. The right thing at the wrong time can be counterproductive, even if you're going in the right direction.
- Let's ramp up our reaching out.
