NO FRUIT, NO ROOT.

Four responses to hearing the Gospel:

- 1) Duped by <u>Satan</u> that the Gospel isn't true 4:4, 15 And as he sowed, some seed fell along the path, and the birds came and devoured it... ¹⁵ And these are the ones along the path, where the word is sown: when they hear, Satan <u>immediately</u> comes and takes away the word that is sown in them.
 - "The Gospel isn't true."

- "I could never live like a true Christ-follower."
- "I'll probably become a Christ-follower...later."
- 2) Deceived by <u>emotions</u> 4:5-6, 17 Other seed fell on rocky ground, where it did not have much soil, and <u>immediately</u> it sprang up, since it had no depth of soil. ⁶ And when the sun rose, it was scorched, and since it had no root, it withered away... ¹⁷ And they have no root in themselves, but endure for a while; then, when tribulation or persecution arises on account of the

 Other seed fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up and <u>choked</u> it, and it yielded no grain...¹⁸ And others are the ones sown among thorns. They are those who hear the word, ¹⁹ but the cares of the world and the deceitfulness of riches and the desires for other things enter in and choke the word, and it proves unfruitful.
- 4) <u>Believed</u> and <u>received</u> the Gospel 4:8-9, 20 And other seeds fell into good soil and produced grain, growing up and increasing and yielding thirtyfold and sixtyfold and a hundredfold." ⁹ And he said, "He who has ears to hear, let him hear."... ²⁰ But those that were sown on the good soil are the ones who hear the word and accept it and bear fruit, thirtyfold and sixtyfold and a hundredfold."
